FREELING SKATE PARK – GATEWAY TO THE F.A.R.M.



Light Regional Council is excited to be working with internationally renowned skate park construction company CONVIC for the design and construction of the Freeling Skate Park upgrade.

Council will match the \$150,000 funding that it received from the Office of Recreation and Sport for the works located on the corner of Hanson Street and Cherry Street at Freeling. This upgraded skate park will be a focal point and a gateway that leads to the FARM centre and the Freeling Recreation Park.

The completion of the project will include a new design skate park taking in the themes of Freeling and surrounds along with seating, paths, drinking fountain and shelter.

Consultation with the community will take place in early February 2020 to finalise designs, with construction expected to be completed by the end of June 2020.
