



LIGHT REGIONAL COUNCIL PUBLIC NOTIFICATION

ROADS (OPENING AND CLOSING) ACT 1991 **Road Closing – Schuster Street, Freeling; Shepherd Street, Freeling;** **Power Street, Freeling**

NOTICE is hereby given, pursuant to section 10 of the *Roads (Opening and Closing) Act 1991*, that the Light Regional Council proposes to make a Road Process Order to close and retain for Council purposes a portion of the public roads adjoining Allotment 523 of Deposited Plan 114299; Allotment 1 of Deposited Plan 61046; Allotment 2 of Deposited Plan 61046; Section 60 of Hundred of Nuriootpa; Section 652 of Hundred of Nuriootpa; Piece 91 of Filed Plan 215246; Allotment 113 of Govt. Town (Freeling); Allotment 132 of Govt. Town (Freeling); Allotment 1 of Deposited Plan 87720; Allotment 300 of Deposited Plan 114659; Piece 2026 of Deposited Plan 121634; and Allotment 181 of Deposited Plan 120000, more particularly delineated and lettered A on Preliminary Plan 19/0026.

The Preliminary Plan and Statement of Persons Affected is available for public inspection at the offices of the Light Regional Council, 93 Main Street, Kapunda, and 7 Hanson Street, Freeling, and the Adelaide Office of the Surveyor-General, during normal office hours. Any application for easement or objection must set out the full name, address and details of the submission and must be fully supported by reasons. The application for easement or objection must be made in writing to the Light Regional Council, PO Box 72 Kapunda SA 5373, WITHIN 28 DAYS OF THIS NOTICE, and a copy must be forwarded to the Surveyor-General at GPO Box 1354, Adelaide 5001. Where a submission is made, the Council will give notification of a meeting at which the matter will be considered.
